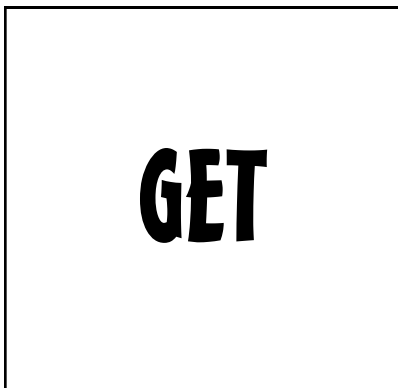

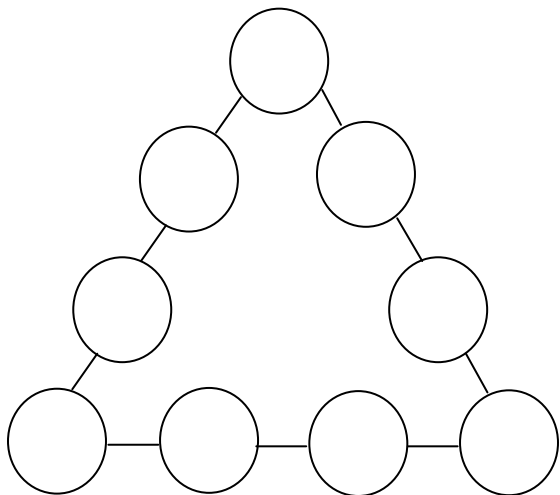
Car Mix-Up
