#### Tournament

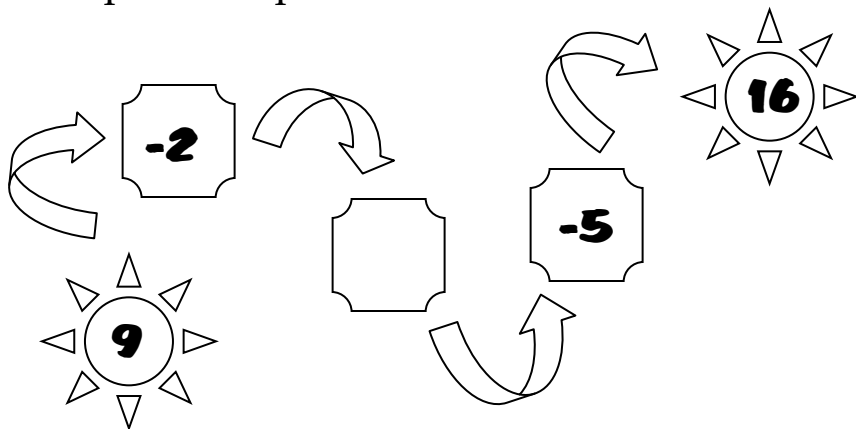
Four friends on different teams competed in a basketball tournament. Use the clues to match the player with their team and the order their team placed in the tournament.
